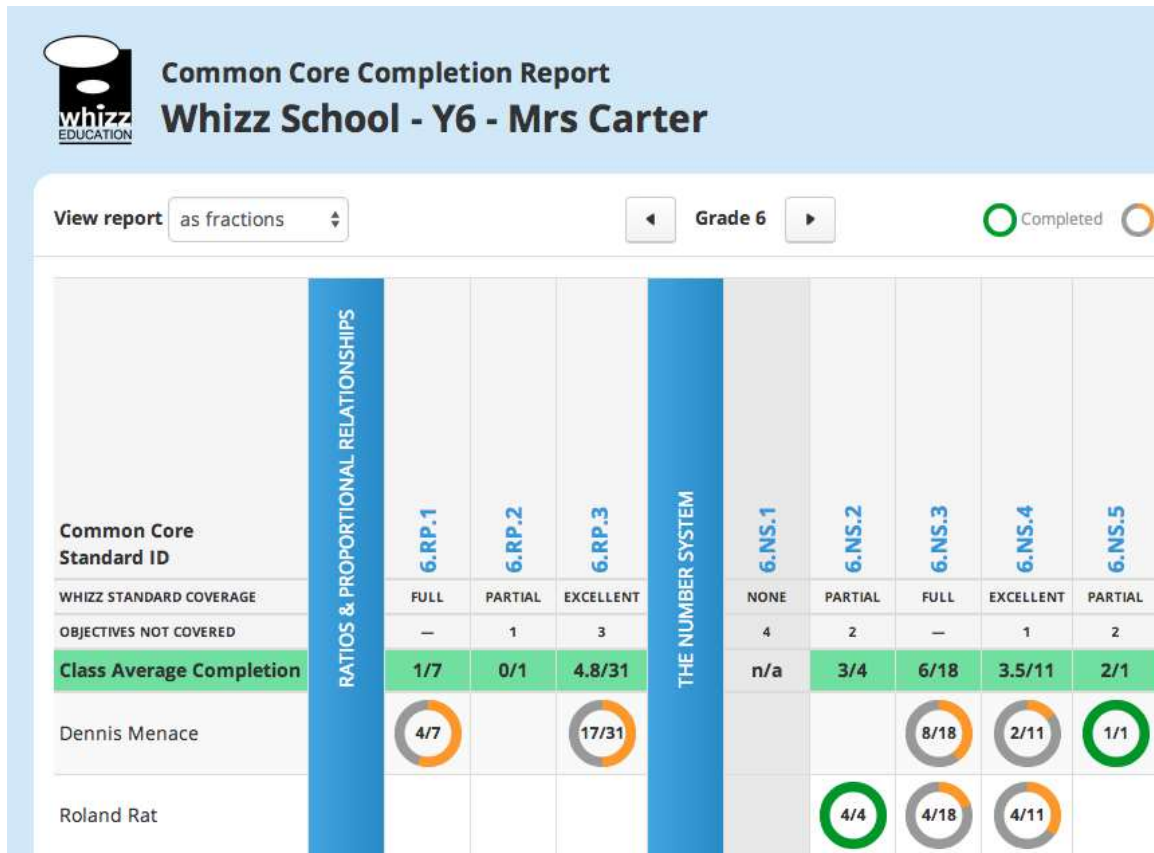

## 1. Overview

The Common Core Completion Report **empowers teachers to** keep track of their students' progress through the Common Core State standards. The report shows how each student is progressing in each standard, displayed in the form of a matrix.

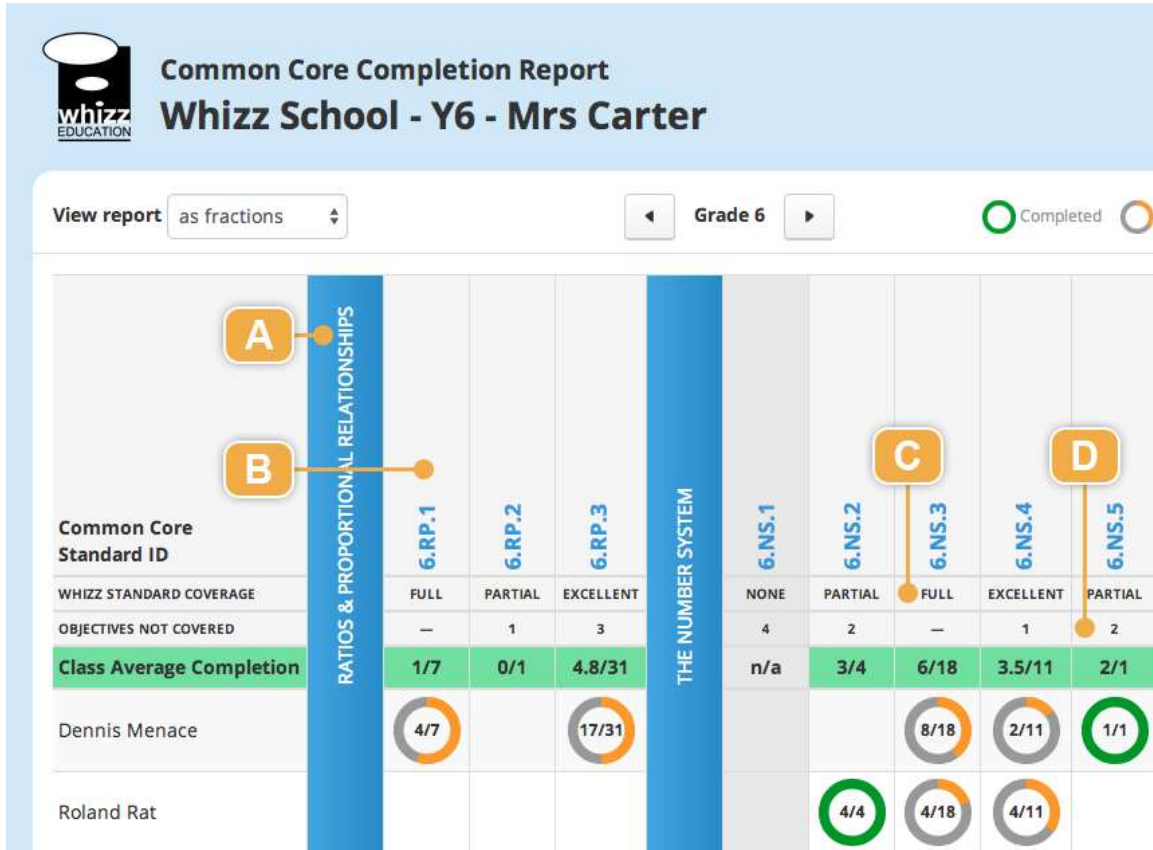
As a Math-Whizz teacher, your Common Core Completion Report will tell you:

- Which Math-Whizz lessons are aligned to each of the 229 standards
- How many learning objectives each of your students (and your class overall) have completed and are yet to complete within each standard



## 2. Standards

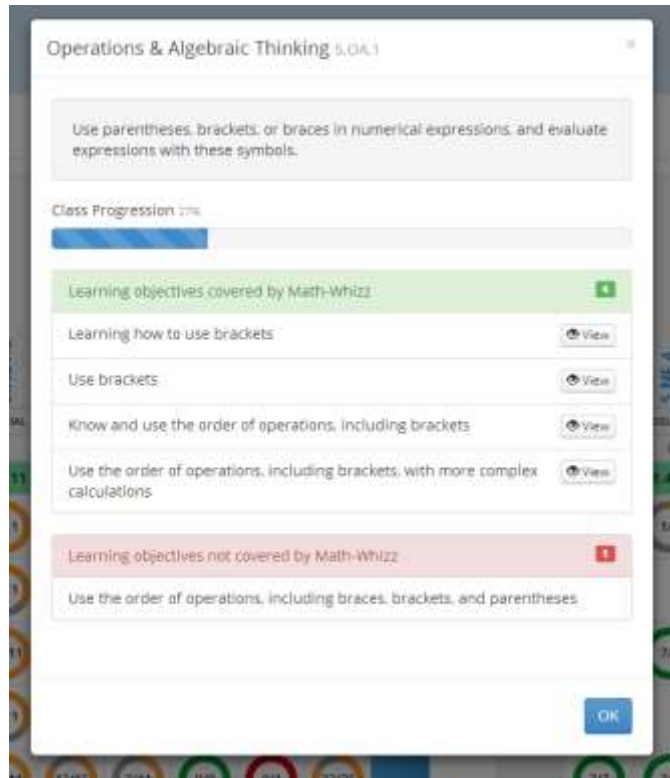
The report organizes Common Core standards into grades and then domains within each grade. A

Each Common Core standard has been broken down into a list of learning objectives. Click on a standard to see the learning objectives that are aligned to that standard within the Math-Whizz curriculum.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Math-Whizz does not yet cover all of the learning objectives in the Common Core standards. To help you fill in the gaps, you can also find a list of learning objectives that are not yet covered by Math-Whizz for each standard.



### Whizz Standard Coverage **C**

Displays the degree of coverage for a given standard in the Math-Whizz curriculum (*Complete, Excellent, Partial or None*).

### Objectives not covered **D**

Displays the number of learning objectives that Whizz does not yet cover for a given standard.



### 3. Completion

'Completion Status' refers to the extent to which a student has covered the available learning objectives within a given standard. If a standard is considered 'complete', this means that the student has passed (or has surpassed the knowledge required for) all learning objectives within the standard (as determined by Math-Whizz within Tutor or assessment mode).

With the help of this report, you will be able to easily identify the 'Completion Status' of each of your students (i.e. the percentage of each standard that has been 'completed'). You can also view the 'Completion Status' for your class as a whole.






**IMPORTANT NOTE:** The Completion Status represents the Math-Whizz learning objectives only. It does not take into account any learning objectives that are not yet covered by Math-Whizz.

#### Completion Status for a student

To see the Completion Status of an individual student in a given standard, find the entry that matches the student and the standard. For example, to see how much of standard 6.NS.5 has been completed by **Dennis**, first find **Dennis Menace** in your list of students , then scroll across until you get to **6.NS.5** .

You will then see a **Completion Status** that displays exactly how much of the standard the student has completed.

	<b>Complete</b> Student has <b>completed all</b> Math-Whizz learning objectives for the given standard
	<b>In progress</b> Student has <b>completed some</b> Math-Whizz learning objectives for the given standard and <b>is not in regression</b> for any of the remaining learning objectives
	<b>In progress, in regression</b> Student has <b>completed some</b> Math-Whizz learning objectives for the given standard and <b>is in regression</b> for at least one of the remaining learning objectives
	<b>No progress, in regression</b> Student has <b>not completed any</b> Math-Whizz learning objectives for the given standard and <b>is in regression</b> for at least one of the learning objectives
	<b>No progress</b> Student has <b>not completed any</b> Math-Whizz learning objectives for the given standard and <b>is not in regression</b> for any of the remaining learning objectives

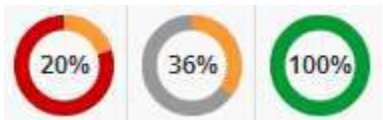
### Completion as a fraction



The fraction inside the circle displays the number of learning objectives that the student has completed (numerator) out of all of the learning objectives that are covered by Math-Whizz for that standard (denominator).

For example, 5/8 means that a student has completed 5 out of the 8 learning objectives for the given standard in the Math-Whizz curriculum.

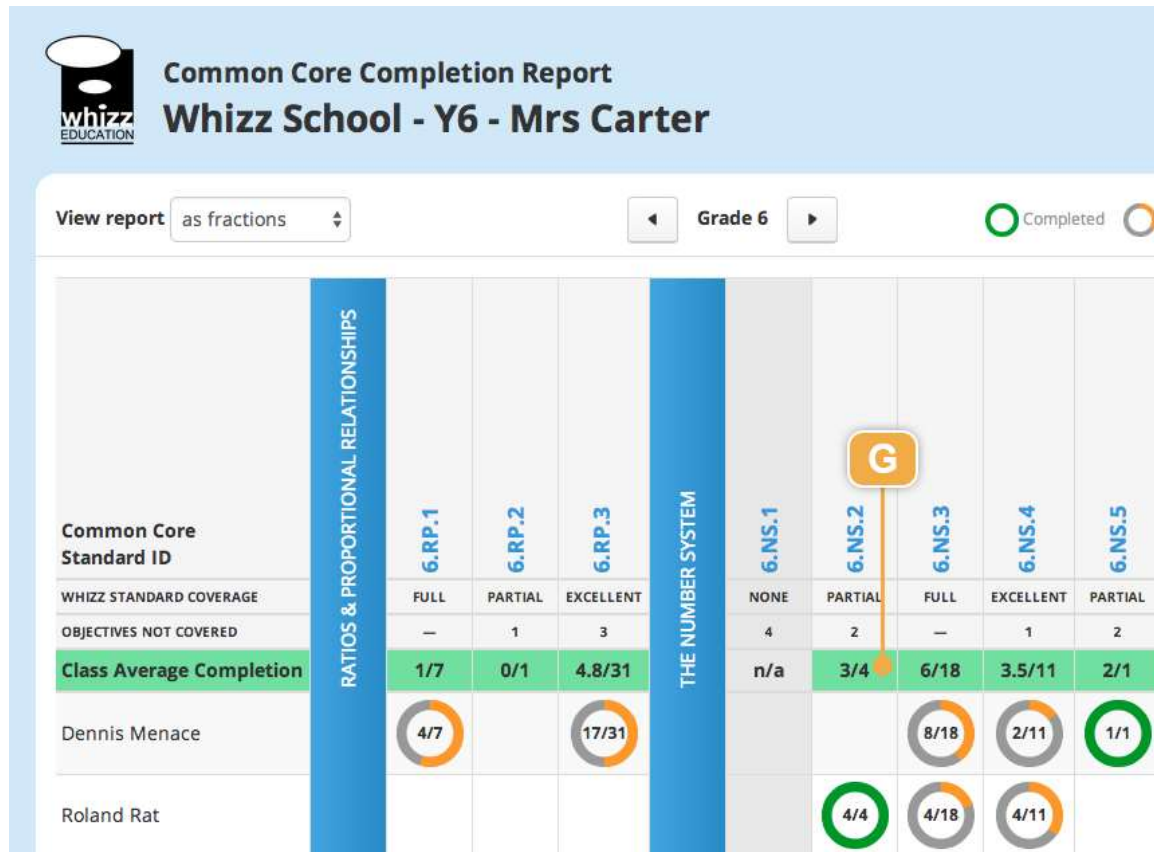
### Completion as a percentage




You can also see the Completion Status as a percentage. This view may be helpful if you want to make comparisons across multiple standards, without taking into account the number of learning objectives in each standard.

To switch between the different types of reporting views, select your desired option from the dropdown box located on the top left of the report.

### Class Average Completion



The Class Average Completion  displays the average number of learning objectives (numerator) completed by students in your class, out of all of the learning objectives covered by Math-Whizz for that standard (denominator).

For example, a Class Average Completion of 5.2/8 means that, on average, your students have completed just over 5 of the 8 learning objectives for that standard in the Math-Whizz curriculum.

As with the Completion Status for each student, you can also view the Class Average Completion as either a fraction or a percentage of the total number of learning objectives covered by Math-Whizz for that standard.
